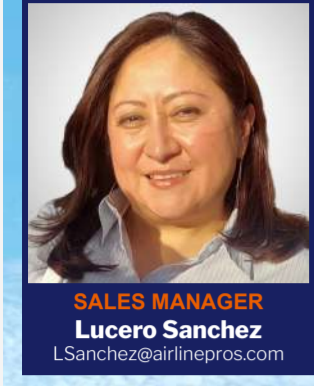

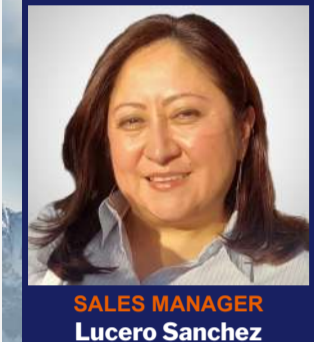

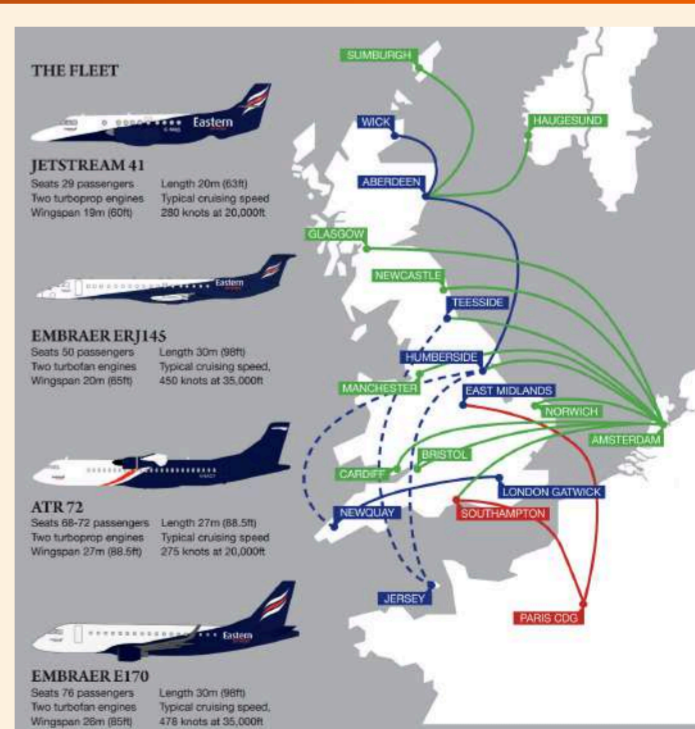
AGENT'S CORNER

Eastern Airways

- Key routes include domestic services to airports such as London (Gatwick), Southampton, Aberdeen, Jersey (seasonal), East Midlands, Humberside, Newquay, Wick, and Teesside.
- Services from the UK to Paris have recently switched to Charles De Gaulle Airport (CDG) following a successful year of flights to Paris Orly.
- The airline's fleet consists of the British Aerospace Jetstream 41, ATR72-600 series turboprop, Embraer regional jets, and Embraer E-jets configured with 29 to 100 signature leather seats.
- Eastern Airways has a commercial agreement with KLM. Both are members of the SkyTeam alliance.

Uganda Airlines

- Visit Uganda! You've heard of the Big Five; however, Uganda boasts its own Big Seven with an estimated 1,063 Mountain Gorillas and 5,000 chimpanzees living in its forests and reserves.
- There are 2,803 mountain ranges in Uganda, eight major rivers, 14 waterfalls, 165 lakes, 202 central forest reserves, and 736 different cultures. (Source: Explore Uganda)
- The source of the Nile is located just outside of Uganda's capital city, Kampala. The trip takes a little over two hours by road.
- Kampala Airport is the former name for Entebbe International Airport. Some sources still use the old name, which can be confusing, but it's the same location!
- A Uganda tourist visa costs US\$50. A valid U.S. passport and a visa is required for travelers visiting from the United States and Canada. Tourist visa applications can be completed and paid for online at <https://visas.immigration.go.ug/>. (Source: Uganda Tourism)
