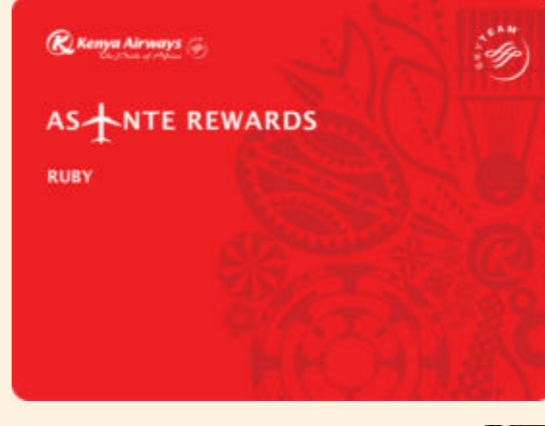
### Kenya Airways
